* Additional Deaths approved for Provision of Ex-gratia assistance as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court. The definition of the COVID-19 death was revised as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court as those cases which are diagnosed through a positive RTPCR/ Molecular Tests/ RAT OR Clinically determined through investigations in a hospital/ in-patient facility by a treating physician, while admitted in the hospital/ in-patient facility. The death occurring within 30 days from the date of testing or from the date of being clinically determined as a COVID-19 case, is also treated as a COVID-19 death even if a death takes place outside the hospital/ in-patient facility. A COVID-19 case while admitted in the hospital/ in-patient facility, and who continued as the same admission beyond 30 days, and dies subsequently, is also treated as a COVID-19 death.
